

HOW TO TIE A Lark's Head Knot

This type of knot is used to attach work to a dowel or ring, to attach new cords to your piece, or to create fringe

Step 1:

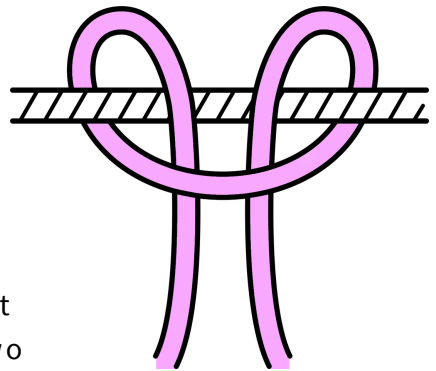
Fold the thread you want to tie, in half down the middle. Placing the folded end behind the place where the knot will be tied.

Step 2:

Pull the cord up and around the object you are tying the knot over, while making sure the cords don't become twisted.

Step 3:

To make the lark's head knot, pull the other two strands through the loop.



Step 4:

To tighten the lark's head knot around the object, hold the two ends of the cord in one hand and the object you tied around in the other and pull.
