Square Knot

This is the most versatile knot and though it can take time to master the correct finger placement, a square knot can be used in many different patterns.

Step 1:

Start with four cords all next to each other.

Step 2:


Bring the far left cord to the right and over the two anchor cords, then place the far right cord over the left cord.

Step 3:

Bring the right cord under the anchors and through the loop formed by the right cord. Pull, and you have the first half of the Square Knot.

Step 4:

Bring the right cord to the left and over the two anchor cords, then place the left cord over it.



Step 5:

Bring the left cord under the anchors and through the loop formed by the right cord. Pull the cords and you have the finished Square Knot.
